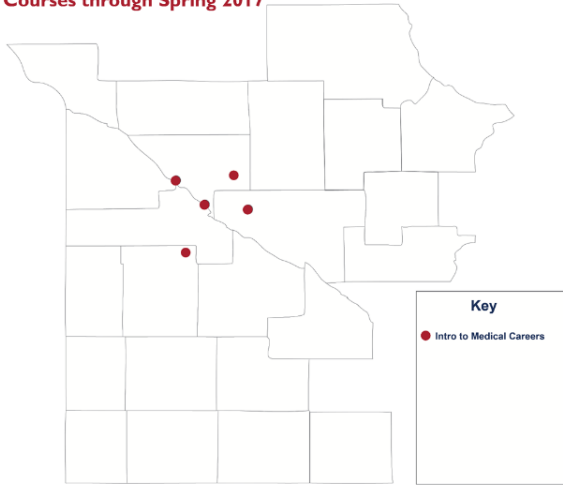


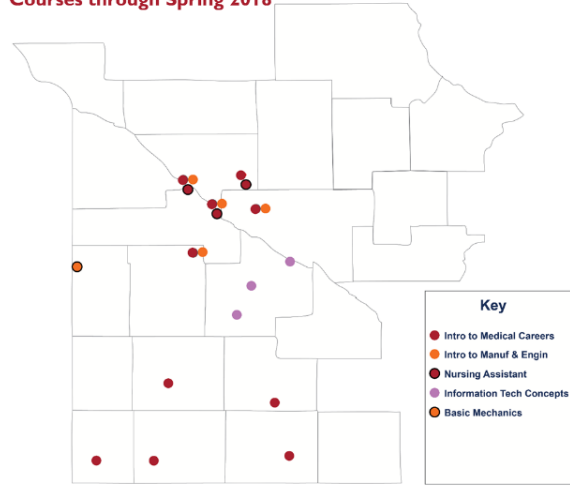

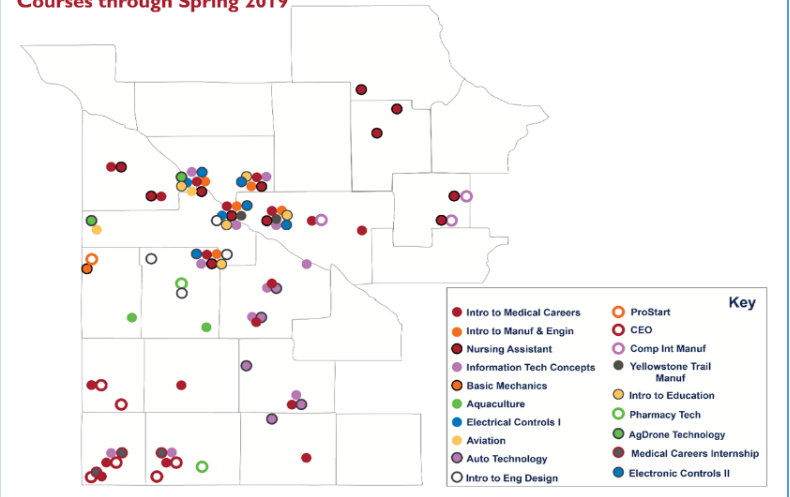
2016-17 School Year Courses through Spring 2017



2017-18 School Year Courses through Spring 2018

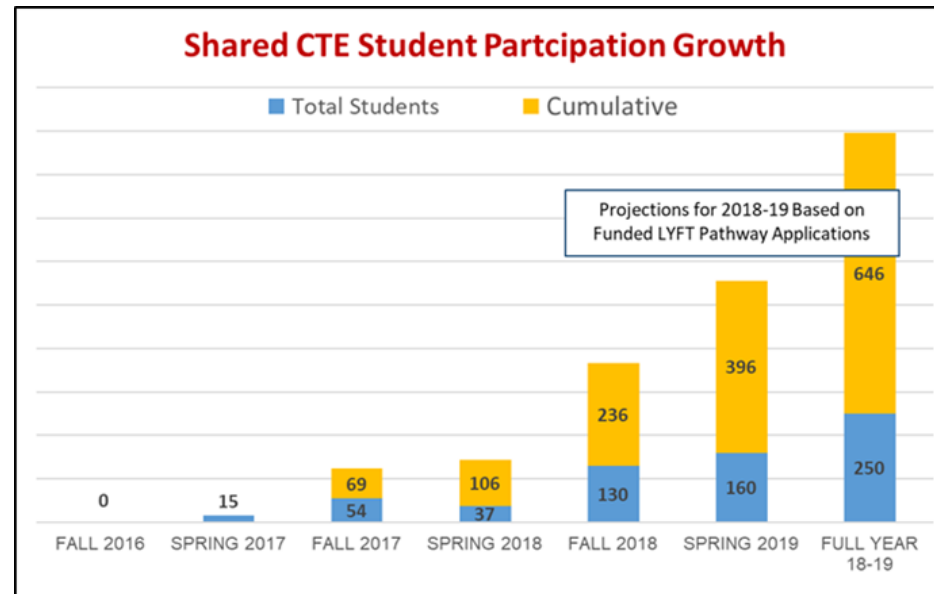
