A partnership between Marshall High School, Murray County Central, Tracy Area High School and the Marshall Area Chamber of Commerce received a \$1,000 LYFT Pathways Innovation award in which 18 students from the Lyon/Murray County Creating Entrepreneurial Opportunities (CEO) program, would commit to attending monthly Young Professionals Meetings. The Marshall Area Chamber of Commerce sponsors the monthly Young Professionals Meetings, which is a group of individuals interested in becoming leaders in the Marshall community.

Marshall Public Schools, Murray County Central Schools and Tracy Area Schools are all part of the Lyon/Murray County Creating Entrepreneurial Opportunities (CEO) program, which consists of 18 students from the three districts.
